On Friday, January 15, the PSC began the task of reviewing the multitude of names brought to our attention as potential candidates for consideration. The number and diversity of qualified candidates is promising, and the committee has begun the task of thoroughly reviewing each candidate. This is a critical stage in our work of discernment for which we ask your continued prayers for insight and guidance as we seek the person we trust God will equip and call to the presidency of LPTS.
