Consequently, because of this bibliography's broad scope you should never use it alone for your research. Taking advantage of the instruction offered by library staff will also greatly facilitate your work in locating reference resources that are not listed in this bibliography.

Though dated, this 20 volume set (plus 10 supplements) is still valuable. It includes over 3,600 biographies of noteworthy persons who lived in the territory now known as the U.S. Includes excellent articles with good bibliographies.

Modern successor to #40. Includes biographies of "persons whose significant actions occurred during his/her residence within the U.S. or whose life and career directly influenced the course of American history." All persons included died before 1996. Entries are long articles with descriptive bibliographies.

Supp. vol. covers 1996 through early 2001. Includes an index of Occupations and Realms of Renown for the full 24 vol. ANB.

One of the newest and best Bible dictionaries available with over one thousand scholarly contributors. Includes surveys and summaries of issues related to every book of the Bible and many non-canonical texts. Also considers major words and every proper name encountered in the Bible along with various historical and archaeological subjects that antedate the 4th century A.D. Entries are long articles with bibliographies.

Entries discuss the name of the god, its etymology and biblical evidence. Extensive bibliographies for each entry.

Two hundred and fifty scholars contributed the articles (most are signed), which have selective bibliographies and numerous illustrations. Moderate to liberal viewpoint in most articles. A basic place to begin research on a biblical topic.

The 1976 supplementary volume updates original volumes and adds new articles. Where an update is provided the entry heading has an asterisk to indicate a similar heading in the original volume.

Articles represent an attitude "of reasonable conservatism," and the evangelical scholars who have contributed represent a variety of denominations and countries.

This work intends "to fill the gap that lies between the commentary and the dictionary. Its main purpose is "to understand a biblical book in its final literary form." Each essay has a selected bibliography.

## VII. SUBJECT CATALOG - *What does this Library have?*

Use the library's automated catalog "Morgan" to find materials on a specific subject that are in this library's collection.

To access "Morgan," on the Web go to the URL <http://www.lpts.edu> , at the center of the screen click on the link "Library on-line catalog" This displays the beginning search screen for the LPTS on-line catalog.

The LPTS Library collection is cataloged using the Library of Congress classification system. The Subject Headings used in this system are the subjects that Morgan looks for when executing subject searches.

To begin searching select the "browse" button – then type in a term and search as LC Subject. Use the list of results to link to records on that topic. Look at the full record and specifically at the subject headings listed for that record. These subject headings can be searched to find additional materials on the same topic.

This is an outline of the call numbers and what subject areas they cover. You can select a topic to see a further break down of that subject.
