Vol. 34 is the Index to the entire set. To find all material related to a topic, i.e. "Apocalypse", look up the term in the Index to see a list of all articles in the previous 33 volumes.

## III. Databases

**ATLA Religion Database**, (direct access in the computer lab) or on the WWW.

this database will help you to quickly access the journal literature, essays in books, and book reviews for religious studies.

Subject Headings to consider searching in this Database

- Angels
- Apocalyptic Literature
- Bible (OT) Daniel
- Bible (NT) -- Prophecies

Search by Scripture Citation

- Daniel
- Revelation

Try pairing terms and searching as keywords – then use the subject headings within the records located this way, for more precise searching.

Remember this and other databases, show you what is available, some but not all of the citations are linked to the full text, if there isn't a link to the full text use the "Electronic Journals" Link available from the main Morgan search screen to see if access to the article's full text is available via another Database.

If the full text isn't available electronically, search the title of the journal to see if the library has a print copy of the journal containing the article.
