- Annual bibliography of mission literature.

- Use the beginning table of contents to find relevant citations, or the indexes at the end of the volume to find entries for individuals or specific mission topics.

Key to finding the most important works on missiology in all European languages published between 1960 and 2000.

Sections on Missions: Methods and Missionaries.

Denominations in America Series - Part 2 is a biographical dictionary of the denomination's leaders, each volume ends with an index, that includes names in the dictionary.

Search the series name by title in Morgan. Then select the record for the denomination you want the call # for.

Page 813 - Appendix for "Study of Culture and Language"

- lists names of individuals who have entries with bibliographic material within the dictionary.

Includes information on pre-20<sup>th</sup> Century Pentecostalism. Global survey and dictionary with index of personal names, groups and associations, and publications.

- list of biographies and autobiographies in English of Missionaries who came to Canada or Canadian missionaries who served in Canada or abroad
- Includes a "Selected Bibliography of Lives"

**REF BV 2040 .E92 2000**

-Overview of mission from differing perspectives, interdenominational in outlook. Lengthy articles (and 483 brief biographies) with bibliographies and cross references to other articles.

Master outline and name index.

**Muller, Karl**, et al., ed. Dictionary of Mission : Theology, History, Perspectives (Lexikon Missionstheologischer). Maryknoll, N.Y. : Orbis Books, c1997.

Provides extended treatment of a wide variety of missiological themes. Plus lengthy bibliographies.

Neill, Stephen, et al., ed. Concise Dictionary of the Christian World Mission. Nashville, TN: Abingdon Press, 1971.

**REF BV 2040 .N44**

Includes biographies of innovators in missions.

Sunquist, Scott. A Dictionary of Asian Christianity. Grand Rapids, MI: Eerdmans, 2001.  
**REF BR 1065 .D52 2001**

Substantive descriptions of Christianity in Asia and its social and political influences.  
Includes entries about particular Christian leaders.

Thomas, Norman E., ed. Classic Texts in Mission and World Christianity. Orbis Books, 1995.  
**REF BV 2061 .C58 1995**

This is in the American Society of Missiology Series which has other titles that explore the study of mission. (To access books in the series do a title search of “American Society of Missiology Series” on Morgan)

Includes an index of names.

## **Searching Morgan – the on-line library catalog**

## Periodical Literature

### ATLA Religion Database

- Supports religious and theological scholarship in graduate education and faculty research
  - Contains thousands of citations from international titles and multi-author works in the field of religion
  - Includes a full range of index citations to journal articles, essays in multi-author works, and book reviews from three ATLA print indexes: Religion Index One (RIO), Religion Index Two (RIT), and Index to Book Reviews in Religion (IBRR)
  - Spans over 50 years with selected records going back to 1818
- direct access in the Computer Lab and over the Internet
  - use the Index button to search a topic to see if it is used by the database
  - try searching these topics as “Descriptors”
    - Missionaries
      - “ - American
      - “ - Biographies
      - “ - Nationality
    - Missions
      - ” - History
    - Missions - Methods
    - Missions - Strategy
    - Missions - Theory
    - Missions/Evangelism
  - search by Denomination then Missions
    - ex. Presbyterian Church (USA) – Missions
  - can search personal names as subject phrase
  - If you get too many hits use the “limit” button
  - If you get very few hits use the “related subjects” button
  - to be comprehensive search topics as a “descriptor” and as a “subject”
  - don’t forget to search for bibliographies and bibliographic essays on your topic.
