ATLA Religion Database

- direct access in the Computer Lab and on the campus network
- use the Index button to search a topic to see if it is included in the database
- try searching these topics as “Descriptors”
 - Cross-Cultural Studies
 - Inculturation
 - Anthropology
 - Missions
 - Missions-Methods
 - Missions-Strategy
 - Missions-Theory
 - Missions/Evangelism
- try searching this topic as a “Subject”
 - Cross-Cultural (with Missions as a keyword)
- If you get too many hits use the “limit” button
- If you get very few hits use the “expand” button
- to be comprehensive search topics as a “descriptor” and then as a “subject”
- don’t forget to search for bibliographies and bibliographic essays on your topic.
