- What electronic tools can shorten my search? The databases listed are available

electronically and are the most important ones for accessing information in the area of Marriage and Family Therapy.

1. Family and Society Studies Worldwide Database

- Scope - Comprehensive, systematic, and non-evaluative resource of research, policy and practice literature in the area of family social sciences.
- Covers the literature from 1970 - on, indexes over 1,000 professional journals, books and popular literature.
- Published by NISC (National Information Services Corp.) DISCover CD Rom Products
- Available in the Computer Lab in the Reference Room of the Library on computers 1-9.
- Search using the "Index Term" option.

2. KYVL - Kentucky Virtual Library

- provides access to a large group of databases including PsycINFO, Medline, ERIC, and Academic Search Elite - Databases that focus on behavioral sciences research.
- direct access in the computer lab, from the **Main Menu** select **Research Databases**, then **KYVL** link then select link for **catalogs and databases**

PsycINFO - access via KYVL database link (see above for accessing)

- contains more than one million references to psychological literature ranging in date from 1887 to the present.
- It provides access to a collection of electronically stored bibliographic references most with abstracts or content summaries.
- covers material published in over 45 countries and written in more than 30 languages.
- Subject Coverage: psychology, sociology, social work, education and other behavioral sciences.
- Indexes material from Psych Abstracts
- Indexes journal articles, dissertations, reports, English-language book chapters and books, and other scholarly documents)
- International in scope; over 1,500 journals from nearly 50 countries; updated monthly.

3. ATLA Religion Database (American Theological Library Association)

- Scope - religion and related field, including pastoral care and social ministry
- Includes the major indexes in the area of religious studies: Religion Index One- Periodicals; Religion Index Two-Multi-Author Works; Index to Book Reviews in Religion.
- Published by the American Theological Religion Association
- Available in the Computer Lab in the Reference Room of the Library

“on-line catalog”
- can search for books identified in bibliographies listed with articles from print resources identified in Section I
- can search by LCSH (Library of Congress Subject Headings) for specific treatment problems.

LCSH – Library of Congress Subject Headings

- to access valid subject headings for your topic, in Morgan, use the “browse” button, type in a topic, search it as “Subject-LC” and use the list of headings that you are directed to.
- if you know the subject heading use the “advanced search” screen, and input the subject and search it as a subject.
- Some useful LCSH for this area of study
 - Family psychotherapy -- Research -- Methodology.
 - Proposal writing in research -- Handbooks, manuals, etc
 - Research -- Evaluation.
 - Research -- Statistical methods.
 - Research design and methods.
 - Social sciences -- Research -- Evaluation.
