Please include the following: 1) Your areas of interest in ministry (immediate and long range); 2) The geographic and cultural location in which you feel you most thrive (area of the country, size of city, etc.); 3) At least three things about you that you consider to be helpful in ministry; 4) At least three areas of growth that you would like to pursue while in seminary; 5) Some interesting personal notes or stories about yourself, e.g. family, hobbies, etc.
- 3. **Brief Statement of Faith (1 page).** Write a brief statement of your faith at this time. Include in your statement comments on your understanding of God, and, if part of a Christian tradition, the life and work of Jesus Christ, the work of the Holy Spirit, the church, and ministry and mission.
