

The Memorial Garden in honor of Lela N. Rhodes Louisville Presbyterian Theological Seminary POLICIES AND FEES

ELIGIBILITY

- Eligibility for a mounting site in the Memorial Garden and interring ashes on the Seminary campus is extended to the following persons and their family members:
 - Students
 - Alums
 - Employees
 - Faculty
 - Trustees
- Family members are defined as an eligible person's spouse, siblings, children, or parents.
- Other friends of the Seminary may be added to the Memorial Garden at the discretion of the President of the Seminary.

PLAQUE MOUNTING

- A location for plaque placement on the Memorial Garden wall may be reserved in advance for a fee of \$1,000. This fee covers the production and mounting of a bronze plaque and the interment of ashes, if requested.
- Family members (as defined above) may reserve adjacent mounting sites for future use, as when available.
- No plaque location may be reserved without receipt of payment by Louisville Seminary.
- Plaque guidelines and templates will be provided by the Philanthropy & Stewardship Office.
- Normal weathering of the plaques should be expected over time. Replacements can be purchased at the current sales price.

INTERMENT OF ASHES

- If interment of ashes is requested, ashes must be placed in a biodegradable container, or they may be committed directly into the soil at the burial site.
- No location within the grounds of the Garden will be designated for a specific individual's ashes.

 Delivery of ashes to the Louisville Seminary campus shall be the responsibility of family members or friends of the deceased. Ashes should be delivered to:

MEMORIAL SERVICE

- Arrangements for a memorial service must be coordinated with the Office of Philanthropy & Stewardship. Such arrangements must be requested seven (7) days in advance. Contact the Office of Philanthropy & Stewardship at 502-992-9353 or giving@lpts.edu.
- Memorial Services held Monday through Thursday will incur a fee of \$100, which includes reservation of the Memorial Garden and six chairs. Services held Friday through Sunday will incur a fee of \$250. A podium and/or tent are available for use, if requested.
- Use of Caldwell Chapel, Seminary buildings, or other campus spaces is NOT included with the fees for a memorial service. Should you wish to request use of these additional campus facilities, please contact Louisville Seminary Events at (502) 992-0220 ext. 437 or Gardencourt@lpts.edu.
