D.Min. Independent Study Form

A Doctor of Ministry Independent Study should be constructed to advance some area of study/scholarship that helps you advance work on your Prospectus [e.g., some portion or all of a literature review, deeper study on an area of ministry, deeper work on your key concepts, reading you're a-level sources, etc.]

A Doctor of Ministry Independent Study is not a tutorial. The student should not plan on faculty instruction, but on guidance in defining the goals and resources for the study and a final evaluation of the study. Faculty members are advised not to offer an Independent Study in place of a regular course or in any instance that could be considered an exception to regular course requirements.

Elements 0-7 of the Prospectus [called the Argument] must be attached to the Doctor of Ministry Independent Study Registration Form.

Planned studies must be proposed and developed in consultation with the Independent Study professor and approved by student's First Reader.
